#### **Student Attendance**

It is critical for all children to be in attendance at school daily. We do realize that from time to time children do get ill, and they should be home. Excusable reasons to keep your child home would be; running a temperature, vomiting, infection that has not been treated with antibiotics for at least 24 hours, funerals, or doctor appointments that cannot be made outside of school time.

You must phone the 24 hour Hotline at (330)875-7610 or call the school at (330)875-1177 before 9:30 am to report your child off of school. When reporting your child off of school, you may also request for homework to be sent home with another student or you can pick it up in the office 3:20-4:15. Upon return to school, the student must bring a written excuse or doctor's slip for an absence to be considered excused.

# Drop Off & Pick Up

The school doors open at 8:20 for our students. Parents will not be permitted to drop off their children before 8:20. The YMCA offers a child care program before school to accommodate children as early as 6:30 AM in our school cafeteria. Please contact them at 330-875-1611. The program has tiered pricing, and is certified for subsidized assistance.

Louisville Elementary will not open doors for students until 8:20 a.m. Students can be dropped off starting at that time. Please do not drop off students prior to 8:20. Once students are in the building, they will report straight to their homeroom. Breakfast will be available for students in each grade level hallway. Students will eat breakfast in their homeroom class. Breakfast is free to all students if they choose to eat breakfast. The school day will begin at 8:35 a.m. It is crucial that all students are in their classrooms by 8:35 for morning announcements. If your child does arrive after 8:35, you must bring your child to the office to sign him or her in.

At the conclusion of the day, car riders will be called down to the cafeteria at approximately 3:00p.m and walkers will be released at approximately 3:15p.m. All walkers will be dismissed out Door #4 (South side of building). If you have a child that is a car rider, it is CRITICIAL that the adults, whom will be picking up that child, have their name on the emergency medical form. A child WILL NOT be released to anyone whose name is not on that list. We ask that whoever is picking up a child, bring their driver's license with them every day. You will need to show your license to the person at your child's table in the cafeteria. A staff member at your child's table may get to know you and may not always need to see your license, but there will be times throughout the year when that adult may be different so it is critical that you have your license each time. We ask that all car riders be picked up by 3:15.
